

Woking walk routes

Listed below are some walk routes that make great lunch time walks, or a lovely weekend wander. They start in Woking and last 30 - 45 minutes. It is suggested that you wear suitable walking shoes and take a water bottle.



Horsell Village walk

- Start in the Town Square and walk down Gloucester Walk, towards the Basingstoke Canal.
- Cross over Victoria Way at the traffic lights and walk over the Victoria Bridge over the canal. The Lightbox will be on your right.
- Walk down the path to the Brewery Road car park and walk around the right hand side of the car park on the footpath.
- Cross over Brewery Road at the pedestrian crossing and continue straight along the footpath.
- The footpath will come out on Horsell Park, cross over and continue straight on up the footpath.
- At the end of the footpath turn left onto Wilson Way.
- When you reach Church Hill you need to cross the road and continue to the left up Church Hill. To cross Church Hill safely, please use the zebra crossing just down to the right.
- Pass Waldens Park road on your right side.
- Veer right down Arthurs Bridge Road continuing until you reach Well Lane.
- Turn left and cross over Lockfield Drive at the pedestrian crossing.
- Once you have crossed Lockfield Drive go through the entrance to the canal towpath. Turn left up the towpath and walk back along the Basingstoke Canal.
- Just before Victoria Bridge go up the set of stairs on your left, cross over the Victoria Bridge and continue back to Woking Town Square.



Woking Park Walk



- Leave Woking Town Square and walk towards the Woking railway station
- Use the pedestrian subway to cross under the railway.
- Continue straight up to Oriental Road – cross over at the zebra crossing and continue down the hill along White Rose Lane, keeping the Royal Mail sorting office on your left.
- Cross over the next road, Heathside crescent, taking care as there is no zebra crossing.
- Carry on down White Rose Lane and take care when crossing Hillview Road, due to traffic.
- Continue along White Rose Lane and take care when crossing Ockenden road.
- Continue along White Rose Lane and turn right through the pedestrian gate for Woking Park and keep right on the footpath around the cricket pitch.
- Carry on along the footpath, veering left, walking past tennis courts on your left.
- Continue on until you reach the bowling green, turning left just before the bowling green.
- Continue down the footpath, passing the Pool in the Park on your left, until you reach the car park. Veer to the right, joining the footpath that goes through the car park and down the drive. Take care of the moving vehicles in the car park.
- When you reach Kingfield Road, turn left on the footpath and continue walking.
- Turn left up the next road, which is Elmbridge Lane.
- Take the next left at the service road to the back of the Woking Leisure Centre.
- Continue straight, up the footpath, with the asphalt courts on your left.
- Cross over the Hoe stream bridge and walking onto the decking and follow the footpath between the two ponds, walking up the slight hill to you reach the cricket pitch.
- Turn right along this path and exit at the White Rose Lane pedestrian gate and retrace your route up White Rose Lane crossing the roads with care and returning through Woking railway station to the Woking Town Square.



Wheatsheaf Common Walk

- Start in Woking Town Square and walk down Gloucester Walk, towards the Basingstoke Canal.
- Pass the Civic Offices on your right, and turn right up the footpath, following along Victoria Way.
- At the next pedestrian crossing cross over Victoria Way and continue walking up Chobham Road, until you reach the common opposite the Wheatsheaf pub (pub on your left).
- Turning right, walk up the common toward the wood at the far end.
- Walk up the slight incline and veer towards the left make sure you follow the pathway heading off to your left when you enter the woodland.
- Continue along this path until it ends and you join a residential road on your right called Elm Road.
- Follow Elm Road to the end and turn right onto Woodham Rise.
- At the end of Woodham Rise turn right onto Chertsey Road (A320) and follow the footpath on the right hand side.
- Just before you would cross the bridge, there is a gap in the wall, with a path leading down towards the wooded land again, turn through this gap.
- Follow the clear path, at one point walking over the small pebbles on the path, until you reach the end and The Grove.
- Continue down The Grove until you reach Chobham Road.
- Turn left onto Chobham Road and carry on until you reach Victoria Way.
- Cross Victoria Way at the pedestrian crossing and turning right to follow the footpath back past the Civic Offices and up to Woking Town Square.

Basingstoke Canal towpath

- Start in the Town Square and walk down Gloucester Walk, towards the Basingstoke Canal.
- Cross over Victoria Way at the traffic lights and walk over the Victoria Bridge over the canal. The Lightbox will be on your right.
- Just over the bridge go down the stairs on your left leading down to the towpath. Choose which direction you would like to walk (left or right) and continue along the path for as long as you wish to walk before turning around and retracing your steps back to Woking Town Square.
