



**STATUTORY NOTICE  
WOKING LOCAL DEVELOPMENT FRAMEWORK**

**Regulation 32 – Consultation on site allocation representations under the  
Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004  
Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004**

Woking Borough Council submitted its Core Strategy to the Secretary of State in October 2006. The document was also subject to consultation to which the Council received representations on site allocations. Site allocation representations are classed as representations which seek to add a site allocation policy to the document or alter any site allocation policy in the document.

The Council conducted a consultation on three sites which ended on 23 February 2007 and it is now necessary for the Council to consult on a further proposal. **Please note that this proposal has not been made by Woking Borough Council.** The proposal is:

Representations may be accompanied by a request to be notified when the examination is to take place and, at a later date, when the Core Strategy has been adopted.
