



Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984: Woking Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Pay And Display And On Foot On Exit) Order 2008 Notice Of Variation Of Parking Charges

Notice is hereby given that Woking Borough Council will on 31 January 2022, under section 35C of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), change various parking charges in some of the car parks identified in the above named order.

The new charges together with existing charges are set out in Schedule I to this Notice.

Schedule: Scale of daily charges for vehicles except motorcycles

Situation of parking place: Victoria Way, Shoppers, Brewery Road and Heathside Crescent

Charges: between 6am and 6pm, Monday to Saturday, including public or bank holidays, excluding Christmas Day. Proposed charge increase highlighted in brackets.

Up to 1 hour: £1.50 (£1.60)

Up to 2 hours: £3 (£3.20)

Up to 3 hours: £4.50 (£4.80)

Up to 4 hours: £6 (£6.40)

Up to 5 hours: £7 (£7.60)

Up to 6 hours: £7 (£7.60)

Up to 7 hours: £11 (£12)

Up to 24 hours: £12 (£13)

Overnight charge (6pm to 6am) flat rate fee: £1.50 (£1.60)

Situation of parking place: Victoria Way, Shoppers, Brewery Road and Heathside Crescent

Charges: between 6am and 6pm on Sundays, excluding Christmas Day.

Proposed charge increase highlighted in brackets.

Up to 1 hour: £1.50 (£1.60)

Up to 2 hours: £2.80 (£3)

Over 2 hours: £3 (£3.30)

Overnight charge (6pm to 6am) flat rate fee: £1.50 (£1.60)

Season ticket charges: Standard charges payable for vehicles that fall within Band C of the DVLA emissions table (vehicles that emit between 121g and 150g of CO2 per KM)

Situation of parking place: Victoria Way and Shoppers, Brewery Road, Heathside

Proposed charge increase highlighted in brackets.

Full year: £1,800 (£1,920)

Quarterly: £550 (£590)

Monthly: £200 (£215)

50% discounts from the season ticket charge are available for those vehicles which fall within Band A of the DVLA CO2 emissions table. Band A vehicles are those that emit 100g or less of carbon dioxide per kilometre.

25% discounts from the season ticket charge are available for those vehicles which fall within Band B of the DVLA CO2 emissions table. Band B vehicles are those that emit between 100g and 120g of carbon dioxide per kilometre.

10% surcharges to the season ticket charge are applicable for those vehicles which fall within Band D of the DVLA CO2 emissions table. Band D vehicles are those that emit between 151g and 165g of carbon dioxide per kilometre.

15% surcharges to the season ticket charge are applicable for those vehicles which fall within Band E of the DVLA CO2 emissions table. Band E vehicles are those that emit between 166g and 185g of carbon dioxide per kilometre.

20% surcharges to the season ticket charge are applicable for those vehicles which fall within Band F of the DVLA CO2 emissions table. Band F vehicles are those that emit between 186g and 225g of carbon dioxide per kilometre.

25% surcharges to the season ticket charge are applicable for those vehicles which fall within Band G of the DVLA CO2 emissions table. Band G vehicles are those that emit 226g or more of carbon dioxide per kilometre.

Situation of parking place: Heathside Crescent, Victoria Way, Shoppers (area 1 residents' 24-hour permit)
