

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Borough Council has received applications for Planning Permission, Conservation Area Consent, Listed Building Consent, potential Departure, Major Development or which may affect a Public Right of Way or for works to trees in a Conservation Area or covered by a Tree Preservation Order, as the case may be, for developments as briefly described in the following schedule:

Town & Country Planning (Listed Buildings & Buildings in Conservation Areas) Regulation 1990

*Dovers Cottage, Barrs Lane, Knaphill, Woking. PLAN/2019/1266/DR: Erection of a first floor side extension and part two storey, part single storey side extension and alterations to fenestration following demolition of existing garages.

*128 Hermitage Woods Crescent, St Johns, Woking. PLAN/2020/0100/WF: Erection of a part two storey, part single storey front extension, roof extension above existing flat-roofed side extension and erection of rear dormer window and front rooflights to facilitate accommodation in the roof space, erection of single storey rear extension and formation of raised rear terrace following demolition of existing extensions.

- *16 Connaught Road, Brookwood, Woking. PLAN/2020/0142/GF: Erection of a two storey side extension and single storey rear extension.
- *94 Woodlands Avenue, West Byfleet, Surrey. PLAN/2020/0145/BRB: Erection of a two storey side and rear extension.
- <u>Chobham Road Bridge, Chobham Road, Woking.</u> PLAN/2020/0172/BRB: Section 73 application for the variation of conditions 2 (plan numbers) of PLAN/2019/0729 dated 26.09.2019 for proposed erection of a new pedestrian/cycle bridge and walkway over Basingstoke canal next to Chobham Road Bridge, including re-alignment works linking the existing towpaths over the canal, associated landscaping to allow the existing road brickwork on the north embankment to be replaced with gabions.
- * As this is a householder application, in the event of an appeal against a refusal of planning permission, which is to be dealt with on the basis of representations in writing, any representations made about this application will be sent to the Secretary of State, and there will be no further opportunity to comment at appeal stage.

NB: You should be aware that the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 2000 allows anyone the right to examine and receive copies of your representations.
