



**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Borough Council has received applications for Planning Permission, Conservation Area Consent, Listed Building Consent, potential Departure, Major Development or which may affect a Public Right of Way or for works to trees in a Conservation Area or covered by a Tree Preservation Order, as the case may be, for developments as briefly described in the following schedule:

**Town & Country Planning (Listed Buildings & Buildings in Conservation Areas) Regulation 1990**

**10A Robin Hood Road, St Johns, Woking. PLAN/2020/0433/JK:** Change of use from office (use class B1) to training academy (use class D1).

**Manor House, Mill Lane, Byfleet, West Byfleet. PLAN/2020/0456/BC:** Construction of two garage buildings following demolition of an existing outbuilding and relocation of another; associated fencing and landscaping.

**\*3 Ferndale Road Horsell Woking. PLAN/2020/0482/JK:** Demolition of a single storey conservatory and the erection of a new single storey extension of the same floor area.

**\*The Hollies 31 Heathside Road Woking. Plan/2020/0530/BC:** Erection of attached garage with accommodation over following demolition of the existing garage.

**\*Copper Beeches, Old Avenue, West Byfleet. PLAN/2020/0532/GF:** Erection of a first floor front extension and single storey rear extension. Erection of a rear dormer and detached garage.

**Manor House, Mill Lane, Byfleet, West Byfleet. PLAN/2020/0456/BC:** Construction of two garage buildings following demolition of an existing outbuilding and relocation of another; associated fencing and landscaping.

**Building D1 Mimbridge Station Road. PLAN/2020/0465/JK:** Erection of a single storey extension.
