***The Glen, The Anthonys, Horsell, Woking.** PLAN/2019/0336/WF: Proposed single storey side and rear extension. **Unit 32-32A, Martland Industrial Estate, Smarts Heath Lane, Woking.** PLAN/2019/0458/TR: Proposed erection of a steel-framed workshop building and a double stacked portacabin to provide office and staff facilities and use of the land for the parking, maintenance and operation of haulage vehicles. ***The Brambles, Littlewick Road, Knaphill, Woking.** PLAN/2019/0490/TR: Proposed single storey rear extension following demolition of the existing conservatory. Fenestration alterations and changes to external materials. Erection of entrance gates. **Garages And Land Between 28 And 30, Albert Drive, Sheerwater, Woking.** PLAN/2019/0564/JH: Demolition of existing garages and erection of a single storey detached building to be used as a dental surgery (Class D1) with associated landscaping, parking and re-alignment of the existing vehicular access to the highway at Albert Drive.
