

WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL THE BROADWAY – PHASE 1 (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2018

Notice of a proposal to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (RTRA 1984) and Regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992 (SI 1992/1215).

- WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL as agent for Surrey County Council (being the Highway Authority) gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the RTRA 1984 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being The Broadway shown coloured RED on the plan attached to the Order ("Plan").
- 2. This Order will close one part of an area of the highway known as The Broadway shown coloured RED on the Plan.
- 3. This Order is needed to facilitate remedial work to the carriageway and willinvolve uplifting loose paving around manhole covers, resetting manhole covers if necessary, relaying sand and brick around the covers and white lining.
- 4. This Order shall come into operation from 11.30pm Monday 16 May 2022 to 6am Tuesday 17 May 2022.
- 5. The Order will restrict traffic access to The Broadway from Maybury Road. Traffic access will also be restricted between The Broadway and Chertsey Road via Locke Way and Duke Street. A signed diversion will be in operation during the works and is show coloured BLUE on the Plan.
- 6. Access for pedestrians will be maintained at all times.
- A copy of the draft Order and Plan may be inspected free of charge at Woking Borough Council, Civic Offices, Gloucester Square, Woking, Surrey GU21 6YL until 17 May 2022 between 9am and 4.45pm, Monday to Friday (excluding bank holidays and public holidays).
