



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ACT 1984 – SECTION 14

WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL (THE BROADWAY No.1) (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2019

NOTICE of a proposal to make a temporary traffic regulation order under section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992 (SI 1992/1215).

1. WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL as agent for SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL (being the Highway Authority) gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under section 14 (1) of the RTRA 1984 and any other enabling powers over (i) an area of the highway being The Broadway, Woking shown coloured RED on the plan attached to the Order ("Plan"); and (ii) reversing the flow of traffic along Locke Way shown coloured YELLOW on the Plan; and (iii) reversing the flow of traffic along part of Duke Street between Locke Way and Maybury Road junctions respectively shown coloured BLUE on the Plan.
2. The Order will:
 - (i) close one part of an area of the highway known as The Broadway shown coloured RED on the Plan;
 - (ii) impose a contraflow system along Locke Way shown coloured YELLOW on the Plan; and
 - (iii) impose a contraflow system along part of Duke Street shown coloured BLUE on the Plan.
3. The Order is needed to facilitate resurfacing of part of The Broadway using block paving to match the paving used within the town centre.
4. If the Order is made, the Order shall come into operation on 19 August 2019 at 12.01am for a period of four weeks.
5. An alternative access route will be available for use while the Order is in force. From Maybury Road turn right into Duke Street, turn left at the junction of Locke Way to access Addison Road and The Broadway.
6. Access for pedestrians will be maintained at all times.
7. A copy of the draft Order and Plan may be inspected free of charge at Woking Borough Council, Civic Offices, Gloucester Square, Woking, Surrey GU21 6YL from 19 August 2019 until 9 September 2019 between the hours of 9am and 4.45pm, Monday to Friday (excluding bank holidays and public holidays).
