

## WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL (CHURCH STREET EST No.2) (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) ORDER 2019 NOTICE of a proposal to make a temporary traffic regulation order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and

regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992 (SI 1992/1215) WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL as agent for SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL (being the Highway Authority) gives notice that it has made an

- Order under section 14(1) of the RTRA 1984 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being Church Street East. Woking shown red on the plan attached to the Order ("Plan").
- 2. The Order closes one part of an area of the highway known as Church Street East shown coloured red on the Plan.
- 3. The Order is needed to facilitate the resurfacing of part of Church Street East using block paving to match the paving used within the town centre.
- The Order is made to take effect from 7pm, Friday 16 August 2019 to 6am, Monday 19 August 2019. 4.
